1. About these terms

These terms govern your use of the website aacm.mc (the "Website"), published by AA Corporate Management ("we", "us", "the Firm").

Enquiries are treated with confidentiality, but sending an enquiry does not create a client relationship or any duty of care until a mandate is accepted in writing.

6. Availability and accuracy

If you choose to write to us, we process the information contained in your correspondence solely in order to respond and, where relevant, to assess a potential mandate. This processing is carried out in accordance with Monaco's personal data protection legislation, under the supervision of the Autorité de Protection des Données Personnelles (APDP). Where a mandate is subsequently entered into, the Firm is also subject to statutory record-keeping and anti-money-laundering obligations.
